

第2問題

*Flags are very interesting, aren't they? Each country around the world has a different flag. Flag colors are cool, too. Many flags are really colorful, and some flags are very simple. Usually the colors have special meanings in each country. There are many different *patterns and many flags have symbols.

Look at the graph. Red is the main color in most flags. Of course, there are many kinds of red too. For example, there is dark red, bright red and light red. The Japanese flag has two colors, and one is red. It is a very easy flag to remember.

But what does red mean for you? In a world color survey by *YouGov in 2015 people said red means power, speed and energy. Do you agree? In Hiroshima, red is the color of the Hiroshima Carp baseball team. The Hiroshima car company Mazda also uses red. This is interesting because scientists say the human brain understands color 60,000 times faster than words. Many companies use red because they think people will buy their products. In fact, when 85% of people go shopping they choose something because of the color.

According to the YouGov survey, blue was the most popular color in the world. People in Europe and Asia said 'blue' means *softness, peace, or

freedom. Think about the sea or the sky. In world flags, red, white and blue is the most popular color *combination. But blue comes after white in the flag graph, doesn't it?

In the survey many people also said that green or red or purple was their second favorite color. Green is as common as yellow in the country flag graph but no country has a flag that is mainly purple. But what do green or purple mean? Let's think about more examples from Hiroshima. According to YouGov, green means peace and *growth. In Hiroshima, the main color of the JT Thunders' volleyball team is green. However, purple means *creativity or *luxury, and it is the main color of Sanfrecce Hiroshima. Sports fans love their team colors, because these colors make them feel great. So they buy the team goods and uniforms.

Color is very important for humans. We always use colors, talk about colors and care about colors. Have you ever thought about color before?

第3問題

Don't you think that Hiroshima is very green? It has many green hills, mountains and river areas, doesn't it? In fact, the color green is also used by the city *streetcars and a bus company. However, the 'Heiwa Odori', or 'Peace Boulevard' is probably the street in the city center that has the most plants and trees. It is also the widest street or road in Hiroshima, and maybe the most famous.

In 1944, during the *Pacific War (1941-1945), a 20-meter wide road was made in Hiroshima for the first time. On August 6th 1945, the *A-bomb was dropped on Hiroshima and 92% of buildings were destroyed or burnt. But this large road was used by people to go in and out of the city.

After the war finished there was a plan in Japan to build 24 big roads in seven large cities. Each road would be 100 meters wide. In these new roads there would be beautiful green spaces and parks. However, many people in these 7 cities didn't like the plan and the big roads were only built in Hiroshima and Nagoya. In 1951, the big road in Hiroshima was first called Peace Boulevard.

But many Hiroshima citizens still didn't want such a big road and in 1955 there was a new plan to change the road from 100 meters to 50 meters wide. Many people said that they needed spaces for houses, not green spaces. However, in 1957 there was another new plan to get donations from people in Hiroshima and all over Japan. Many *donations came from America and South American countries such as Brazil, Argentina and Peru.

Many events started to be held on Peace Boulevard. For example, in 1957 a *circus came. Then, in 1958 a 50-day festival for the *reconstruction of Hiroshima was held and 870,000 people visited. And, in 1965 when the road was finally finished, the city had a big parade. Hiroshima Carp won their first Central League Championship ten years later in 1975 and they had a parade too - 300,000 people came to the event.

Some events now are held on Peace Boulevard every year. The most special is the Flower Festival because many people come from all over Japan to see it. Over 1,500,000 people came in Golden Week in 2019 to enjoy this festival. In 1999, a winter festival of lights started. It is now called the 'Dreamination'.

People from all over Japan come to enjoy these two events.

Today, Hiroshima City has about 88 green parks and areas. There are many *A-bombed trees around Peace Boulevard, and in the city. There are many *monuments too. They tell us about Hiroshima's history and Hiroshima today.
